Breve descrizione:

Il progetto "School Corner " consentirà la realizzazione di una rivista scolastica curata da studenti delle scuole secondarie che avranno così l'opportunità di esprimersi e parlare dei reciproci interessi attraverso un lavoro di collaborazione. Il lavoro sarà un modo “eccellente” per comprendere storie personali e sociali, comunicare le “ scoperte” in modo creativo, sviluppare una conoscenza culturale condivisa sottolineando la dimensione europea del patrimonio culturale #eTwForCulture. Il progetto ha avuto inizio ad ottobre 2018 e terminerà presumibilmente entro maggio 2019. E’ prevista la pubblicazione di 3 numeri della rivista: un numero di autunno, uno invernale e un numero di primavera che darà il benvenuto all'estate successiva.

About the project

The project 'School corner' is going to be about a school magazine created by secondary school students who will have the opportunity to express themselves and talk about their interests through their cooperative work. It will be an excellent way to realize who they are and how they could communicate their findings creatively, so they develop a shared cultural knowledge and emphasize the European dimension of the Cultural Heritage #eTwForCulture. The project will last from October 2018 to May 2019 and we expect to release 3 issues, one autumn issue, one winter one and one spring issue welcoming the following summer.

Aims

This project will provide a real audience into the English language classroom. The students will work with authentic material they have chosen, they will learn how to summarize and interpret texts, and they will develop cultural values and refresh politeness rules. They will also learn how to build and organize an oral discourse, practice conversation and everyday language and improve their self-evaluating skills.

Work process

We intend to work simultaneously on the project. We will involve two classes-groups of students of the same age. We will spend one hour per week on the project. The students will be in groups which will



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involve students from different countries. Each group will choose a subject they have decided to work on. There might be groups of students in the same country depending on the subjects they want to work on. They are about to write one or two pages each and then decide on the title of the magazine they have to create. Online quizzes will help them edit their magazine. Google documents, padlet, eTwinning live chat, tricider and the platform appear in will be used to help with the communication between the participants.

Expected results

The final product will be a school magazine (3 issues) made by students for students. The relevant material pictures and live chats will be presented on our twinspace. The pages will help the students have an overview of what they are supposed to do and a place to upload their material.
